## H.H. DORJE CHANG BUDDHA III

In 2006 a manuscript copy of the book A Treasury of True Buddha-Dharma, which documents a few of the many accomplishments of His Holiness Wan Ko Yeshe Norbu (Master Wan Ko Yee), was distributed to the leaders of various Buddhist sects. These were incarnated Buddhas and Bodhisattvas who were greatly accomplished themselves. After reviewing the book, they were shocked and wondered what type of person had come to this world. The Five Vidyas are the manifestation of the powers and wisdoms of holy beings. These vidyas represent the realization of Buddhas and Bodhisattvas—they are the result of what holy beings do. They encompass everything seen and unseen, animate and inanimate in the universe that is beneficial to living beings. To develop everything that is good is called "bright (vidya)." Everything in the entire universe is classified into five aspects of brightness and darkness. That is the real meaning of the Five Vidyas.

The accomplishments of H.H. Dorje Chang Buddha III Wan Ko Yeshe Norbu are not limited to the human realm or even to sentient beings. Animals and beings from other realms have taken refuge in His Holiness and come to listen to His discourses. In order to manifest holy power from beyond the Three Worlds, His Holiness has also taken mist from the air with His hand, put it inside a hole in a sculpted boulder, and made it stay there. This miraculous creation is now on display in California for all

to appreciate. Those who see it are amazed and blessed by it.

This book is a treasure never before seen in the past several thousand years. It proves that the true Buddhadharma expounded by Shakyamuni Buddha and this ancient Buddha does still exist in this world as it was originally transmitted and that it is possible to obtain by all who want to learn it.
